## HOW TO REPORT A TAGGED TURKEY VULTURE TO THE USGS BANDING LAB

You will need the following information to complete the report:

- Wing tag number (any corresponding symbol such as a dot ●)
- Wing tag color
- Wing tag location on the right or left wing
- Date and location of bird sighting
- Other notable information (e.g., alive/dead) as requested

Example: white wing tag, "1A dot", on right (as shown)  $\rightarrow$
